

16 Romans Memory Verses - one from each chapter

Romans 1:17	In the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last.
Romans 2:11	God does not show favoritism.
Romans 3:22	This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe.
Romans 4:25	He [Jesus] was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.
Romans 5:8	But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Romans 6:11	Count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.
Romans 7:24-25	What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? Thanks be to God - through Jesus Christ our Lord!
Romans 8:31	If God is for us, who can be against us?
Romans 9:23	He did this to make the riches of His glory known to the objects of His mercy.
Romans 10:10	It is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.
Romans 11:36	For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever! Amen.
Romans 12:2	Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - His good, pleasing and perfect will.
Romans 13:12	The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light.
Romans 14:10	Why do you judge your brother? Or why do you look down on your brother? For we will all stand before God's judgment seat.
Romans 15:13	May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
Romans 16:19-20	Be wise about what is good, and innocent about what is evil. The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet.
